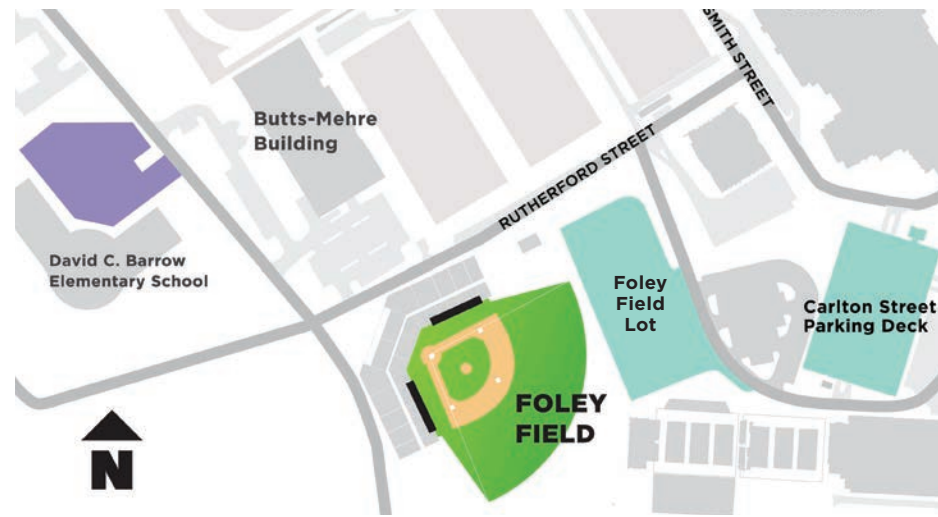

POSTSEASON TICKETS

REGIONAL/SUPER REGIONAL

Reserved & Premium Seating: If UGA were to host a Regional or Super Regional, baseball postseason ticket locations are assigned based on cumulative TGBC priority points and availability. The maximum number of tickets you can request is 8. The number of season tickets you have will be allocated first, and the remainder of your request will be processed based on availability.

College World Series: The following chart outlines the maximum number of College World Series (CWS) tickets that you may request based on your 2022 GBF contribution or your involvement with the Magill Society. CWS ticket locations are assigned based on priority and availability. Qualifying to request tickets **does not** guarantee assignment.

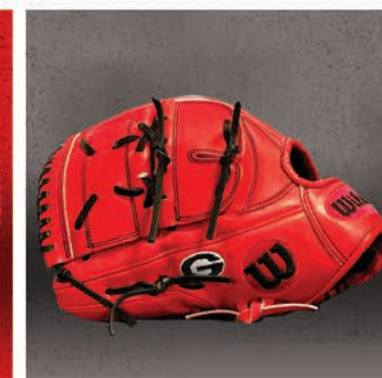
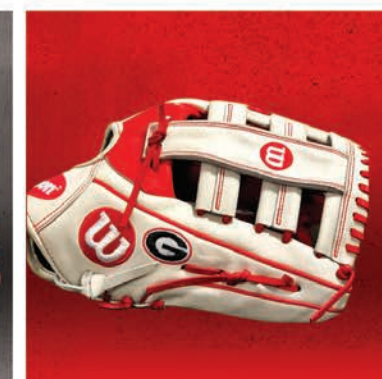
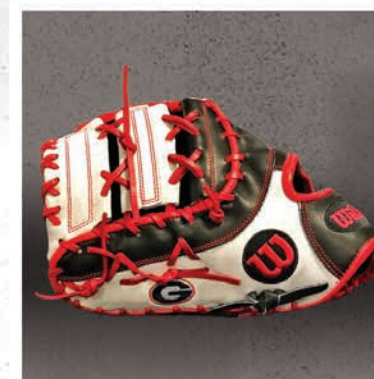

TICKET ASSIGNMENT PROCESS

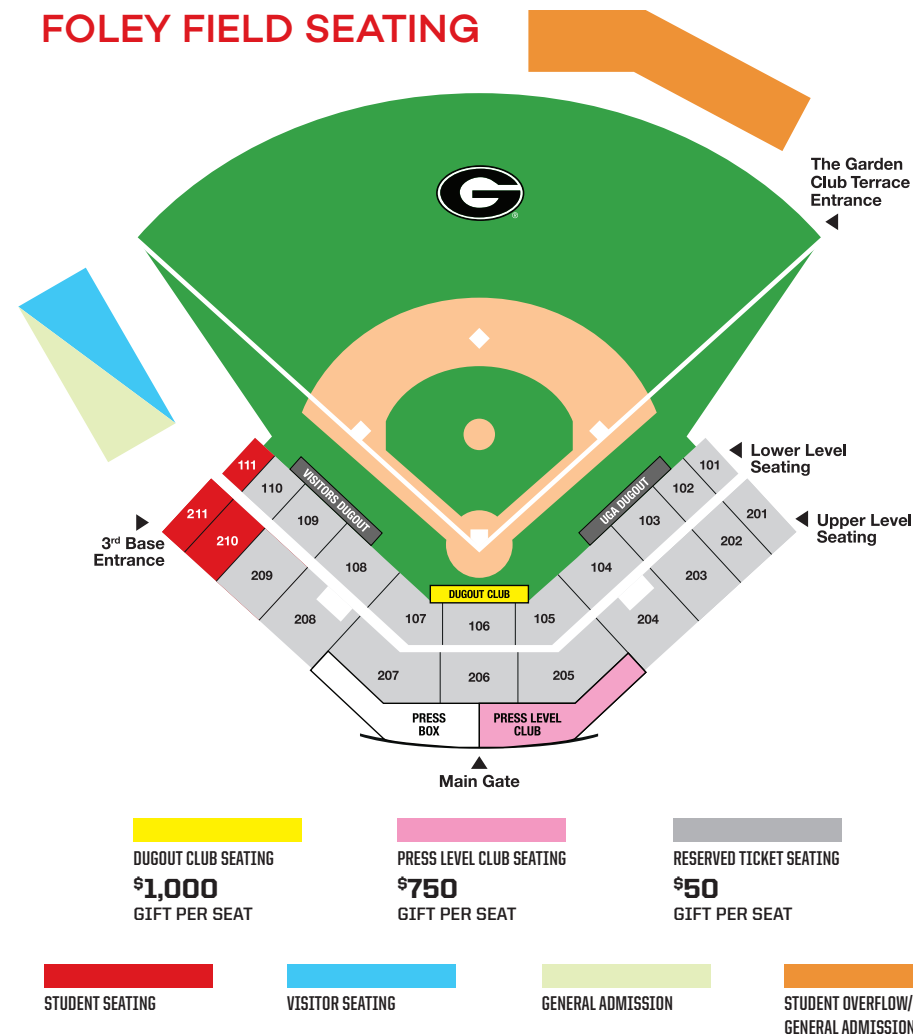
The Georgia Bulldog Club (TGBC) and the University of Georgia Athletic Association Ticket Office manually assign baseball season, single home game, and postseason tickets based on cumulative TGBC priority points and availability. Season tickets in the stands require a minimum \$50 per-seat donation to the Georgia Baseball Fund in order to have the first right to renew the location on an annual basis. GBF donors are eligible to purchase up to 8 season tickets, with a maximum of 4 in the premium areas (based on availability). **The donation and season ticket deadline is January 14, 2022.**

All 2020 baseball season ticket holders will have the first right to renew their existing seats by meeting the necessary GBF and season ticket requirements and deadline.

GAME DAY HOSPITALITY

Please note that premium seating opportunities at Foley Field are limited due to minimal season ticket attrition in these areas. An account making the minimum per seat donation and season ticket payment does not guarantee assignment. If there is availability, all requests are allocated based on cumulative TGBC priority points.



Dugout Club
Purchase of season tickets and minimum \$1,000 GBF per-seat gift required

Located field-level behind home plate, the Dugout Club opens one hour prior to the scheduled start of the game and features climate-controlled indoor space with food, snacks, and refreshments. One of the most unique premium areas in college baseball offers two rows of outdoor seating and reserved indoor bar rail window seating, along with indoor high-top tables and seats located behind the back stop between the dugouts.



Press Level Club
Purchase of season tickets and minimum \$750 GBF per-seat gift required

Located directly next to the Press Box and behind section 205, the Press Level Club opens one hour prior to the scheduled start of the game and features climate-controlled indoor space with food, snacks, and refreshments. The club space has covered outdoor seating and reserved indoor bar rail window seating, along with indoor high-top tables and seats.
