



PARKING MAP



Thank you for being part of the GymDog family. We can't wait to see you in Stegeman Coliseum this season.



PRIORITY POINT SYSTEM

The Georgia Bulldog Club calculates your priority point total based on cumulative giving towards UGA Athletics. Members are ranked in order based on cumulative TGBC priority point total for ticket opportunities including renewable season tickets, single meet, and postseason competitions.

TICKET ASSIGNMENT PROCESS

All donations and ticket requests will be due November 17th. New season ticket requests and renewals (if desired) will participate in the Online Seat and Parking Selection Process in mid-December 2025. To be considered for relocation, you must select "YES" when prompted on your online season ticket application. Everyone who opts in to the process will receive an appointment time. All season ticket selections through this process will be based upon availability at the time of your selection, which is dictated based on your cumulative TGBC priority points total, and applicable GEF minimums being met. This is required for all donors who are requesting renewable season tickets and/or parking. If you do not wish to relocate your current seats and/or parking, you do not have to participate in the selection process. As a reminder, you retain the ability to renew the same seat locations that you held for the 2025 season.

POSTSEASON TICKET ASSIGNMENT PROCESS

The 2026 SEC Gymnastics Championship will begin on March 21, 2026. Ticket locations are assigned based on cumulative TGBC priority points and availability, whereas the quantity of tickets that you can request is based on your 2026 Gymnastics Excellence Fund (GEF) gift or level of involvement in the Magill Society. The donation deadline to establish point-based priority for postseason is March 1, 2026. Qualifying to request tickets does not guarantee assignment.

2026 HOSPITALITY INFORMATION



All Gymnastics Excellence Fund (GEF) donors who contribute \$1,000 or more and have one or more season tickets will have the opportunity to request access to the Courtside Club Hospitality room. The number of passes will be dictated based on the number of season tickets

purchased. Courtside Club opens up 60 minutes prior to the start of the meet and ends at the beginning of introductions.
