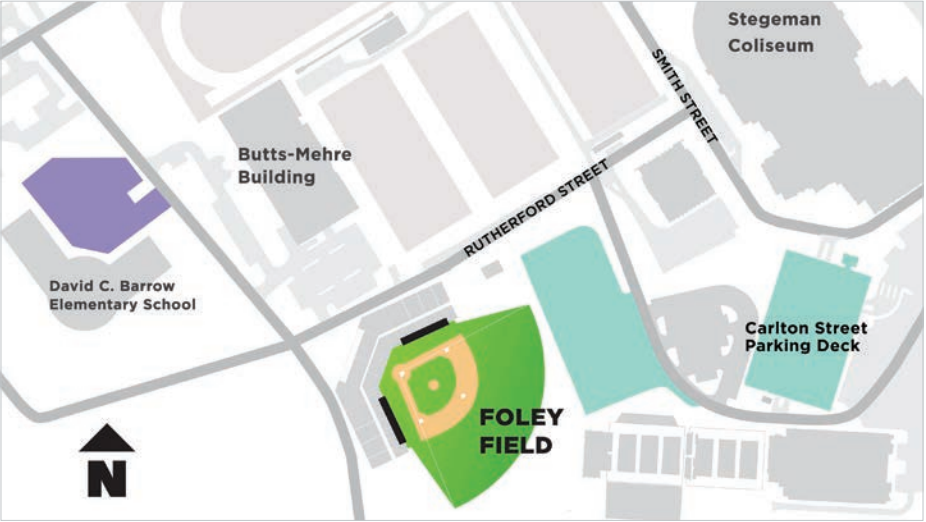


PARKING MAP



PRIORITY PARKING
\$2,500 MINIMUM
CONTRIBUTION REQUIREMENT



GENERAL PUBLIC
FREE PARKING

Access to request reserved baseball parking in the Barrow Elementary Lot requires a minimum of \$2,500 SWBF contribution. Qualifying to request does not guarantee assignment. Allocations are based on cumulative TGBC priority points and availability. Donors who make the minimum \$2,500 SWBF contribution will have the first right to renew their parking location from the 2025 season. There may be some select home games where priority parking is unavailable based on game time.



POSTSEASON TICKETS

REGIONAL / SUPER REGIONAL / COLLEGE WORLD SERIES

If UGA hosts a Regional or Super Regional, baseball postseason ticket locations will be assigned based on cumulative TGBC priority points and availability. The quantity of tickets that an account can request is based on its 2026 Steve Webber Baseball Fund (SWBF) gift or commitment to the Magill Society.

The following chart outlines the maximum number of Regional, Super Regional, and/or College World Series tickets that an account may request based on its 2026 SWBF contribution or commitment to the Magill Society. The donation deadline to establish point-based priority for postseason ticket allocation is May 15, 2026.

Qualifying to request tickets does not guarantee assignment.

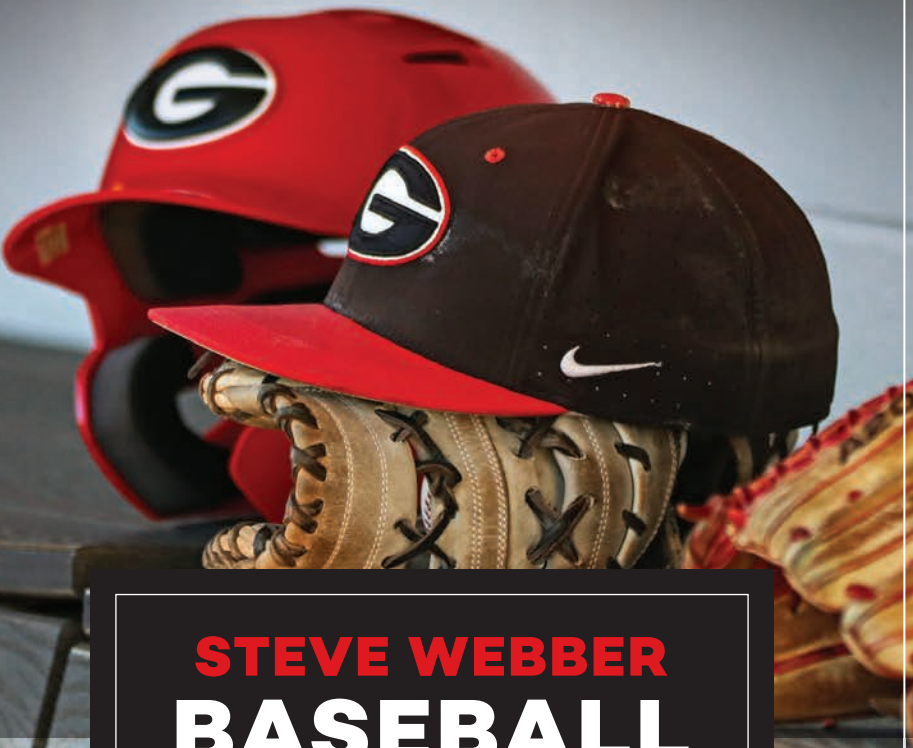

The UGA Athletic Association is pleased to announce that the Georgia Baseball Fund is being renamed the Steve Webber Baseball Fund in recognition of Coach Webber's incredible impact on UGA Baseball. During his 16-year tenure as head coach of UGA Baseball from 1981 to 1996, Coach Webber tallied 500 victories as his teams averaged 32 victories per season. A native Iowan and graduate of Southern Illinois University, Webber took a pair of Bulldog teams to Omaha for the College World Series (CWS), which marked the first two appearances for the program in school history. In 1990, Coach Webber's team earned the first national championship for the Southeastern Conference in baseball. Webber was named SEC Coach of the Year in 1987 and National Coach of the Year in 1990.

POWERHOUSE PACKAGE

The 2026 Powerhouse Package will include reserved ticket seating to all Southeastern Conference (SEC) home games. It will also include general admission seating for the opening series vs. Wright State as well as ETSU on April 14th and Troy on April 28th.

TICKET ASSIGNMENT PROCESS

All donations and ticket requests will be due January 6th. New Powerhouse Package requests and renewals (if desired) will participate in the Online Seat Selection Process in late January 2026. To be considered for relocation, you must select "YES" when prompted on your online Powerhouse Package renewal. Everyone who opts in to the process will receive an appointment time. All Powerhouse Package selections through this process will be based upon availability at the time of your selection, which is dictated based on your cumulative TGBC priority points total, and applicable SWBF minimums being met. This is required for all donors who are requesting renewable Powerhouse Packages and/or parking. If you do not wish to relocate your current seats and/or parking, you do not have to participate in the selection process. As a reminder, you retain the ability to renew the same seat locations that you held for the 2025 season.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1 Do I have to participate in the seat selection process?

No. If you are satisfied with your current seat location(s) and current quantity of tickets, you do not have to participate in the seat selection process.
- 2 Am I able to request additional tickets in 2026?

Yes. Any additional tickets must be purchased and the minimum per-seat contribution paid by the January 6, 2026 deadline. If you do not select additional seats or there are no seats available at your appointment time, you can either receive a refund on the cost of your tickets or roll the money over to the 2027 SWBF. Contributions to the SWBF are non-refundable.
- 3 Will there be multiple accounts selecting at the same time?

Yes, there will most likely be multiple members selecting seats at the same time as appointments times overlap.
- 4 What if I miss my appointment or am unavailable at my assigned appointment time?

If you miss your time, you can log in at any point after your allotted time to make selections. Please note you will sacrifice your priority place in line if you miss your appointment time as others will be logging in for selection throughout the day. If you are not available for your appointment time, you can assign a proxy to select seats on your behalf. If you choose to do so, please email The Georgia Bulldog Club at bulldogclub@uga.edu so that we may assist that individual if questions arise during the appointment time.
- 5 Can I log in prior to my appointment time to look at open inventory?

Yes. Account holders will receive an email notification when the selection website is available for viewing. At that time, additional information will be provided on how to navigate the selection site. You will not be able to make any selections, but you will be able to see and track available inventory in real time.
