POSTSEASON TICKET ASSIGNMENT PROCESS

All Andy Landers Women's Basketball Fund donors may request up to 8 postseason tickets. Women's Basketball postseason ticket locations are assigned based on cumulative TGBC priority points and availability. The donation deadline to establish point-based priority for postseason is February 1, 2027. Qualifying to request tickets does not guarantee assignment.

All Andy Landers Women's Basketball Fund donors who contribute \$1,000 or more and have at least one season ticket will have access to the Courtside Club hospitality room. The number of passes will be determined by the number of season tickets purchased with a max of 4 passes at the \$1,000 giving level, and a max of 8



All tickets for the 2026-27 women's basketball season will be digital. This will provide fans with contactless entry to all games and ease of transferability.

Donations to the Andy Landers Women's Basketball Fund through The Georgia Bulldog Club are non-refundable.

An account, including the associated priority points and season tickets, may only be transferred to a spouse at the time of death.

The UGA Athletic Association is pleased to announce that the Georgia Women's Basketball Fund is being renamed the **Andy Landers Women's Basketball Fund** in recognition of Coach Landers' incredible impact on UGA Women's Basketball. During his 37-year tenure as head coach from 1979 to 2015, Women's Basketball Hall of Famer Andy Landers recorded 944 career victories and established the Lady Bulldogs among the nation's elite programs. A native of Maryville, Tenn., Landers became one of just seven coaches in NCAA Division I men's and women's basketball history to surpass 850 wins. Under his leadership, Georgia advanced to 20 Sweet 16s, 11 Elite Eights, five Final Fours and two NCAA runner-up finishes, while earning numerous national honors. Landers is a member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame and the State of Georgia Sports Hall of Fame.

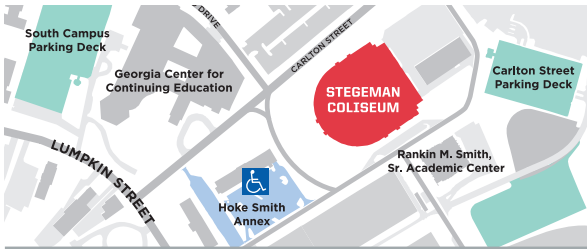

RESERVED SEATS

We offer a hybrid reserved season ticket model, which includes 5 different price points at Stegeman Coliseum based on location to enhance the experience for all of our Andy Landers Women's Basketball Fund supporters and student-athletes. All lower level season tickets will cost \$55 each plus a corresponding per-seat contribution. All upper level general admission season tickets will cost \$55 each with no per-seat contribution required.

All 2025-26 women's basketball season ticket holders will have the first right to renew their existing seats by meeting the necessary ALWBF and season ticket requirements by the September 1, 2026, deadline.

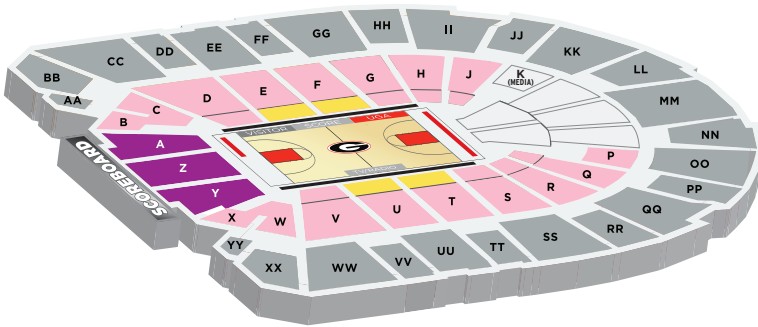
TICKET ASSIGNMENT PROCESS

All donations and ticket requests will be due September 1, 2026. New season ticket purchasers and renewing donors (if desired) will have the opportunity to participate in the Online Seat and Parking Selection Process in late Sept/early Oct 2026. Participation is required for all donors who are requesting new, renewable season tickets and/or parking. If you do not wish to relocate your current seats and/or parking, you do not have to participate in the selection process. As a reminder, you retain the ability to renew your same seat locations held during the 2025-26 season by meeting the necessary ALWBF contribution requirements. Those who request general admission sections (dictated via the season ticket application) will not need to participate in the seat selection process as these sections (shaded in gray) will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.
